- To give a clinical updated overview on the main STIs and describe the diagnostic process from patient to the lab and back to the patient for a correct treatment.
- To interactively discuss with participants clinical cases examining clinical, diagnostic, psychological aspects in the context of a public health intervention directed to prevent disease complications and spread.
- At the end of the course participants will achieve a level of knowledge that will enable them to properly manage STIs at both individual and public health level.

The course will include lectures given by expert scientists in the field, interactive group discussions, individual exercises and role playing.
